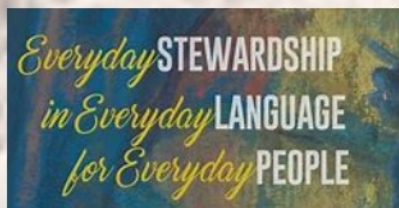

Those who are bound by this may take only one full meal. Two smaller meals are permitted if necessary to maintain strength according to one's needs, but eating solid foods between meals is not permitted. ** **Abstinence from meat** is to be observed by all Catholics 14 years old and older on **all Fridays**.
